### **Materials:**

**A Bit of String**

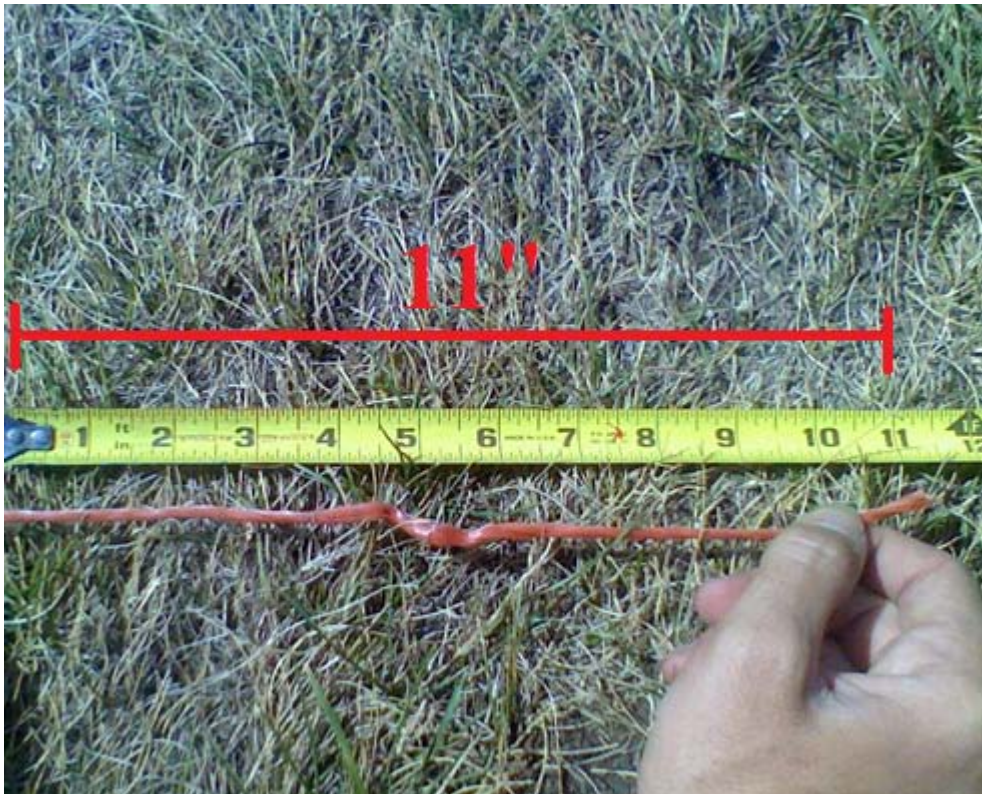
**Tape Measure**

**Watering Can - 1 gallon or larger**

- 1. Make sure you read all instructions on the bottle to be sure **Tree & Shrub** is appropriate for your application.**



**2. Measure around the trunk of the tree with a string.**



**3. Then measure the circumference of the tree. Our tree is about 11" around.**



**4. Mix the solution. For every one inch of circumference add 1 ounce of solution to 1 gallon of water. Our tree is 11 inches in circumference, so we'll add 11 ounces of solution to one gallon of water in our watering can.**



**5. Then just pour the solution around the base of the tree.**
